This position requires extensive knowledge of horticulture / agronomy. This position is supported by seasonal harvest labor and part-time employees to assist in the management of River Ridge Organics. The successful candidate will report directly to the General Manager.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Cost controls on farm inputs
- Build and update annual budgets
- Maintaining existing customer accounts and creating new accounts
- Implementing new and effective management strategies
- Continued management of existing plants
- Management of all supplemental employees
- Scheduling irrigation, pruning and sprays
- Maintenance of the pack house and equipment
- Communication with both Organic and Gap certifiers

- Degree in Horticulture / Agronomy (Experience can be substituted)
- Strong work ethic / self-starter
- Strong communication skills
- Management experience
